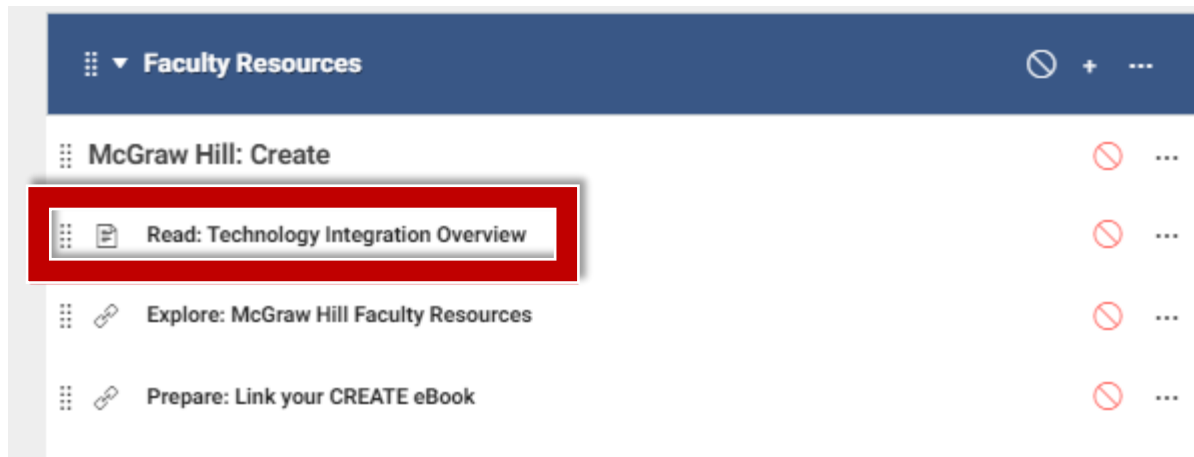

Step 1

Log into your Canvas course. Locate the “**McGraw Hill: Create**” section within your Faculty Resources. Click the first link “**Read: Technology Integration Overview**” to begin.





Step 2

In step 2 on this page, you will see the ISBN needed for linking to your eBook. Take a moment to write it down or copy it for later by selecting the ISBN > Right-Click > **“Copy”**.

When ready, click **“Next”** to continue.

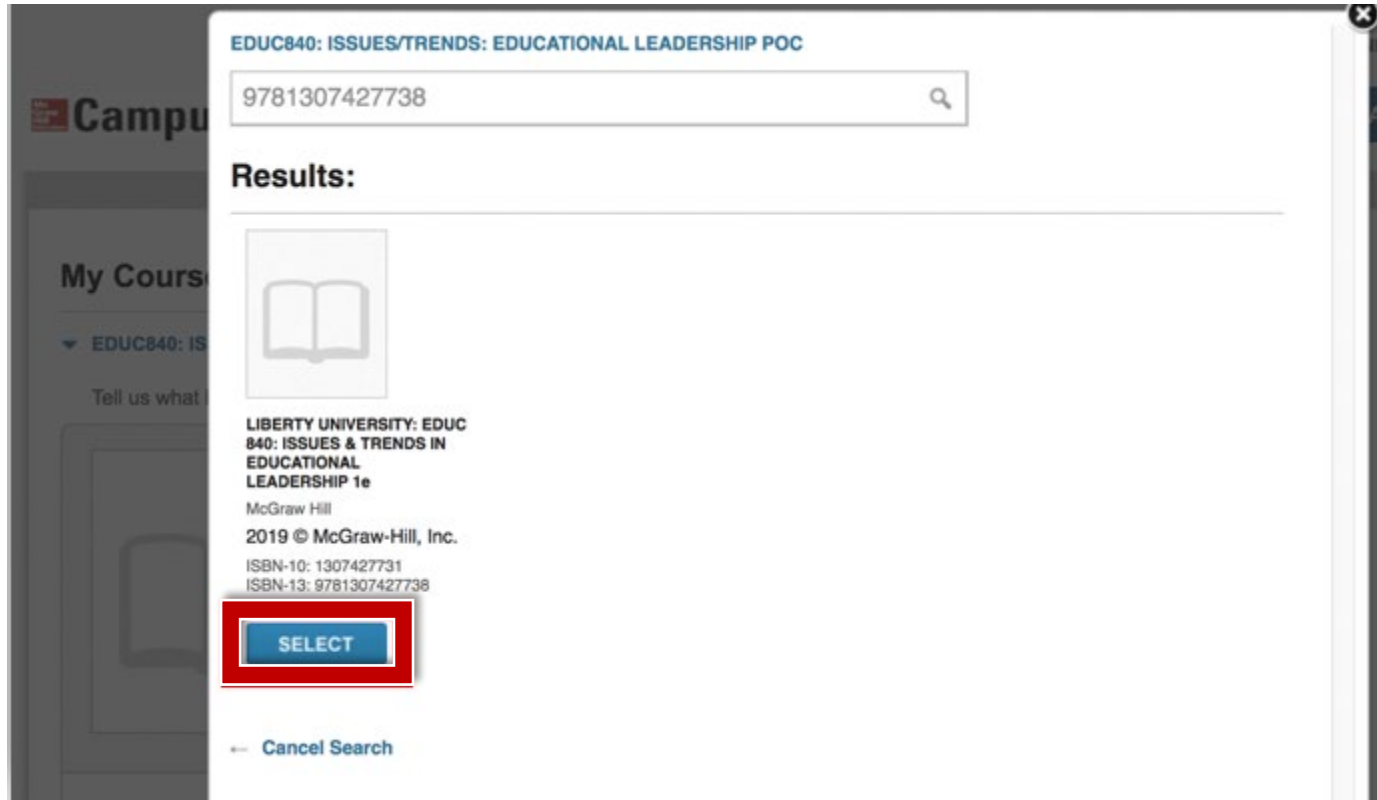
